02. Webinar on Construction Costing And Budgeting

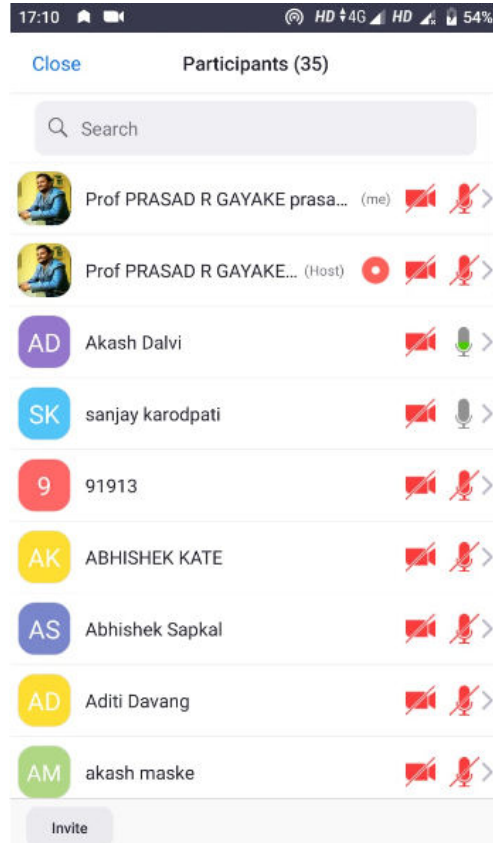
