A meeting will be conducted on January 19, 2023, at 10:30 AM in Room No. 302.

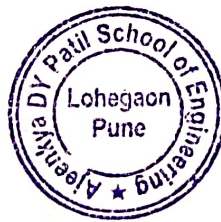

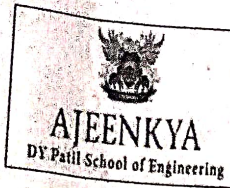
- (1) Teach basic physical self-defense techniques

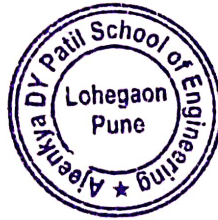
