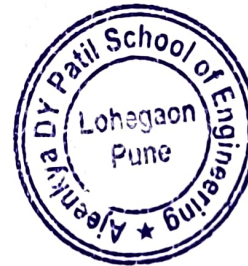
A meeting will be conducted on **June 19, 2023**, at **1:30 PM** in **Room No. 305**.
