# Quality Policy

We strive to impart the quality technical education through academic excellence and provide best of facilities to satisfy the need & expectations of the students & stakeholders.

#### 1. Goals of awarding scholarships, prizes and medals to students:

- a) In order to promote an outstanding or excellent academic performance, excellence in a given course of the program, excellence in research, social service, games and sports, cultural activities, participation in students counseling, participation and constructive leadership in gymkhana involving all-round overall performance, the Institute may award various scholarships, prizes, medals and awards either from its own funds or from funds obtained from non-governmental sources.
- b) In order to promote the study at the postgraduate level, the Institute may award various scholarships/assistantships to its students either from its own funds or from funds obtained from other governmental or non-governmental sources.
- c) In order to promote research and development in a specified field, the Institute may award various scholarships, prizes and medals to its undergraduate as well as postgraduate students

#### 2. Financial assistance from Institute funds:

#### Merit Scholarships for Undergraduate Students:

In order to financially assist meritorious students coming from economically weaker background, the Institute awards Merit-scholarship to needy students from its own funds.

#### 3. Tution fee waiver for Post Graduate students:

The DYPSOE provides  $50\,\%$  fee waiver scheme to its regular students in different postgraduate programmes.

#### 4. Institute level Awards and Prizes:

The DYPSOE gives attractive cash prizes and certificates to the first two toppers of each department and for outstanding performance in curricular and extra curricular POLICY FOR NON-GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

activities of undergraduate students.

#### 5. Assistance for other scholarships:

Institute motivates and provides the assistance to the undergraduate and post graduate students to take the benefits of other non-governmental scholarships from the outside sources.

#### 6. General Guidelines:

- i) All scholarships and awards are liable to withdrawl partially or fully in case of misconduct by the award winner. A similar action may also be taken if it is found that a student has deliberately misguided the Scholarships, Prizes and Awards Committee by giving false information.
- ii) A student leaving the College on his/her own accord without completing the prescribed program of study may be required to refund the amount of scholarship received by him/her in that academic year.
- iii) A student may normally receive only one scholarship. In case he/she is awarded more than one scholarship/stipend from any outside source, he/she shall be given the option to choose one scholarship from various alternatives and surrender the other.
- iv) No scholarships will be paid for the month subsequent to the one in which the student completes the examination of all prescribed courses.
