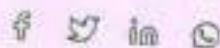

Introduction:

The "One Week National Level Faculty Development Program on Cloud Infrastructure (AWS)" was organized by Brainovision Solutions India Pvt. Ltd. In coordination with Department of AI & DS from August 21 to August 25, 2023. Program Schedule and Highlights:

Day 1: August 21, 2023

Topic: Introduction to Cloud Computing and AWS

The program commenced with a formal inauguration, setting the tone for the week-long development session. The day's primary focus was an introduction to cloud computing and an overview of AWS's role in the cloud ecosystem.

- **Overview of Cloud Computing:**
 - The fundamental principles of cloud computing, including its significance and advantages in modern IT environments.
 - Key cloud service models: IaaS, PaaS, and SaaS.
- **Introduction to AWS:**
 - AWS architecture and global infrastructure.
 - Core AWS services such as EC2, S3, and Lambda.
- **Interactive Session:**
 - Participants learned how to create AWS accounts and launch their first EC2 instance, providing hands-on experience with AWS.

Day 2: August 22, 2023

Topic: AWS Compute and Storage Services

The second day focused on providing a detailed understanding of AWS compute and storage services.

- **AWS EC2 and Compute Services:**
 - Detailed session on Amazon Elastic Compute Cloud (EC2), focusing on how to provision, configure, and manage virtual machines.
 - Introduction to auto-scaling and load balancing in



- **Amazon S3 and Cloud Storage Solutions:**

- Comprehensive overview of **Amazon S3** (Simple Storage Service) for object storage, including security features like bucket policies and access control.
- Overview of AWS storage classes, including Glacier for archival storage.

- **Hands-on Lab:**

- Participants deployed virtual machines using EC2 and stored files in S3, reinforcing theoretical knowledge with practical application.

Day 3: August 23, 2023

Topic: Networking and Security in AWS

Day 3 centered on understanding networking services and security practices within the AWS ecosystem.

- **Virtual Private Cloud (VPC):**

- In-depth discussion on creating and managing **Virtual Private Clouds** (VPCs), subnets, and routing tables.
- Setting up secure communication between VPCs and public/private instances.

- **Security and Compliance on AWS:**

- Best practices for ensuring security in cloud environments using **AWS Identity and Access Management (IAM)**.
- Overview of compliance services and encryption tools provided by AWS.

- **Hands-on Lab:**

- Participants designed and launched a secure network using VPCs and applied IAM policies to control access.

Day 4: August 24, 2023

Topic: Advanced AWS Services and Serverless Architecture

The fourth day of the program introduced participants to advanced AWS services and serverless computing.

- **Serverless Computing with AWS Lambda:**



- Overview of **AWS Lambda**, which allows the execution of code without provisioning servers.
- Real-world applications of serverless architecture in modern cloud-native applications.
- **Database Services:**
 - Introduction to **AWS RDS** (Relational Database Service) and **DynamoDB** for scalable database management.
 - Participants explored how to set up databases in the cloud and manage data effectively.
- **Monitoring and Cost Optimization:**
 - Overview of **AWS CloudWatch** for monitoring resources.
 - Strategies for optimizing AWS costs through pricing models, reserved instances, and elasticity.
- **Hands-on Lab:**
 - Participants created a serverless function using Lambda and integrated it with S3 for event-driven processing.

Day 5: August 25, 2023

Topic: Capstone Project and Evaluation

The final day of the program culminated in a comprehensive capstone project that allowed participants to apply the knowledge they had gained throughout the week.

- **Capstone Project:**
 - Participants were grouped and tasked with designing a cloud-based infrastructure using AWS, incorporating networking, compute, storage, and security elements.
 - The projects were reviewed and evaluated based on implementation, innovation, and adherence to best practices.
- **Feedback and Certification:**
 - An interactive feedback session allowed participants to share their learning experiences and suggest improvements for future programs.



- o Participants were awarded certificates of completion, validating their newly acquired expertise in cloud infrastructure and AWS services.
