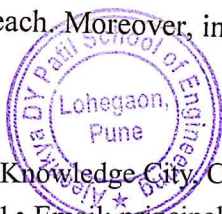

NABL- TCS (Testing and Consultancy Services) Lab:

The TCS Lab, a unique Testing and Consultancy Services Lab of the institute, holds a unique distinction in the Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) as the only lab to achieve National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) accreditation. This accreditation, obtained in September 2021, covers a comprehensive range of 33 tests. The lab's commitment to quality and professionalism has earned them an impressive clientele, including reputed private builders, government organizations, and educational institutions. Currently, the lab serves 122 clients and has generated total revenue of Rs. 25.91 lakhs till date. To enhance sample collection from different sites, the lab acquired a Maruti EECO vehicle, improving efficiency. In addition to its contributions to testing and consultancy services, the lab actively supports academic excellence. It awards scholarships to meritorious students, recognizing their achievements and providing financial assistance. In the academic year 20- 21, two outstanding girl students were awarded a prize of Rs 5,000 each. Moreover, in the current year 22- 23, the lab has rewarded five



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meritorious students with bicycles worth Rs 6,000 each. This initiative not only recognizes the students' achievements but also promotes environmental awareness among the students and society. The lab also actively participates in the Earn and Learn scheme of SPPU, offering valuable learning and earning opportunities to 25 students. Through this program, students gain practical experience and enhance their skills while earning income. Additionally, the lab has facilitated placements for 13 students in reputed construction companies, showcasing the practical experience and knowledge gained through their time in the TCS Lab. Looking ahead, the TCS Lab has ambitious plans to expand its services and obtain NABL accreditation for its geotechnical and environmental lab by September 2023. These expansions will further enhance the lab's capabilities and contribute to its mission of providing cutting-edge services in the field. The lab's commitment to excellence, academic support, and industry exposure not only benefits its clients but also empowers students and faculty members, ensuring a holistic growth and development ecosystem in the field of testing and consultancy services. Along with the TCS lab, the institute also helps to develop teamwork and communication skills of students through Go-Karting.

Go-Kart:

Go-karting enthusiasts have a thrilling opportunity to participate in the Auto India Racing Championship (AIRC) organized exclusively by the institute across India. Our college boasts a unique 1 km track dedicated to go-kart racing, providing an exhilarating experience for enthusiasts. The last AIRC event attracted 28 teams across the country, with college in-house teams showcasing their racing skills and passion. The SAE Club at the institute, in collaboration with SAE India is proud to host the prestigious Autonomous BAJA Event, drawing talented individuals nationwide. Excitingly, the institute plans to launch its own E- go kart Racing event, offering students a platform to explore electric vehicle knowledge.

Innovation Ecosystem:

The institute's Centre for Innovation Incubation and Entrepreneurship (CIIE) nurtures student innovation. The center has a Technology Business Incubator (TBI), an Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell, and Entrepreneurship Cells. The TBI cell is equipped with 3D printers, software, ASUS, Raspberry Pi, and a product development lab, enabling students to bring their ideas to life. Over 20 ideation sessions have been conducted, generating 100+ ideas for patents. We have published 11 patents, with 6 granted and copyrights. The Government of India sanctioned 81.9 lakhs for the 'SPRING' project. The center aims to enhance the innovation ecosystem, empowering students as successful entrepreneurs and change-makers in their chosen fields.




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Center of Excellence: IIT Kanpur:

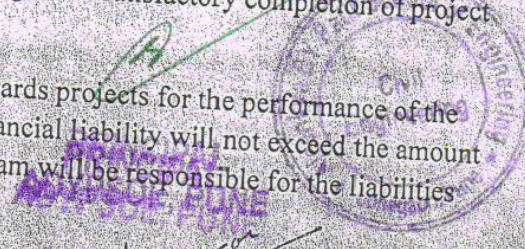
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On following terms

- 1) The new entity generated will be called as Testing and Consultancy Services Cell (TCSC). The objective of setting up of "Testing and Consultancy Services Cell (TCSC)" in Civil Engineering Department of the Institute, is to establish platform for better interaction between practitioners from Business/Industries/Govt. Organizations and Academicians and also the students of Dr. D.Y. Patil School of Engineering, Charholi (BK), Lohgaon, Pune to synergies in practice and theory for the mutual benefit of the parties involved including student fraternities and the Society at large.
- 2) Besides creating a contingency fund to be used for effective maintenance and small repairs of the Laboratory equipment and machines in all the laboratories of the Department, the Institute may score some valuable points in the regular Inspection for Accreditation of National Board of Accreditation (NBA) and National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), for offering Engineering Consultancy and undertaking Civil Engineering Research work to Industries/Govt. Institutions. The additional advantage is that the academic experts and final year students will have practical experience through the project, adding value to their caliber for the larger benefit of the Institute, Society and state.
- a) **Party No.-I**, will be the promotor and also overall monitor and controller to the activity under separate Entity, TCSC with distinct legal identity under the financial and administrative control of the Management only.
- b) The said association firm may also take **Service Tax and Income Tax** registration from respective Departments of Government of Maharashtra.
- c) This deed of association is made in personnel name of people occupying the post of Facilitator, TCSC. In case of any change of person from the post, only resignations from the post holder will be accepted de facto and new facilitators if appointed may also be recorded in the register to be maintained with promoters.
- d) The **Party No.-I** have all rights of changing the position and responsibilities of the Facilitator. Also **Party No.-I** shall appoint a successor, in case, **Party No.-2** discontinues.
- e) The **Party No.-2** will discontinue being associated with the cell once he ceases to be part of the college.
- f) In case of partly completed assignments if any of the associates want to leave the project in between for completion. The substitute should be arranged for satisfactory completion of project by the newly appointed facilitators.
- g) Their will be no responsibility of the promoters towards projects for the performance of the project otherwise than when expressly agreed. The financial liability will not exceed the amount expressly accepted. The project Coordinator and his team will be responsible for the liabilities that may arise.



- h) The cell will be paying such percentage as may be agreed as infrastructure charges to the promoters for use of infrastructure or resources of the college.
- i) The employment of the facilitator with Dr. DYP SOE is prerequisite to be member of this association. The promoter may permit the deviation in this rule.
- j) The accounts will be audited by Chartered accountant every year
- k) The current Account in the Bank for day today transactions will be opened and operated by Party No.2 jointly with T.C.S.C. Coordinator of Civil Engineering Department, with two signatures viz. i.e. T.C.S.C. Coordinator and Facilitator (TCSC).
- l) All the statutory dues are to be paid on time and the facilitator will be fully responsible for the same
- m) The revenue generated shall be distributed among Institute and faculty members as per the approved Schedule by management. All the money transaction and disbursement shall be carried out subject to approval of CAO or any other authorized person of institute appointed by Dr.D.Y.Patil Charitable Trust from time to time.

3) MANPOWER, EQUIPMENTS / MACHINES REQUIRED FOR THE ACTIVITIES OF TCSC:

a) The Institute has following laboratories

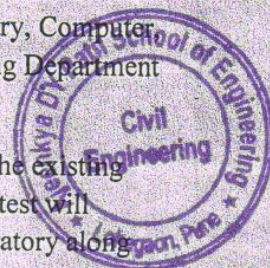
- i) Engineering Mechanics
- ii) Survey
- ii) Fluid Mechanics
- iv) Testing of material
- v) Geotechnical Engineering
- vi) Engineering Geology
- vii) Transportation Engineering
- viii) Environmental Engineering

The work of material testing, Civil Engineering consultancy and Research will be limited to the availability of the equipment, machines and Research facilities available in the department including above mentioned existing laboratories. The facilities like use of Stationary, Computer and Software etc. shall be utilized from the available resources in Civil Engineering Department of the Institute.

- b) All the material testing work will be carried out **after working hours** through the existing faculty members directed by the **Party No.-2**, and HOD (Civil). Generally 1(one) test will require 2(Two) faculty members out of which 1(one) will be from respective laboratory along



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with 1(one) each Laboratory Assistant and Attendant. The performance of test and preparation of Report will be the responsibility of the 1st (first) faculty member while checking the report and obtaining signature of HOD (Civil) and Facilitator will be the responsibility of the 2nd (second) faculty member. After obtaining the signature of Facilitator, the test report will be handed over to the Client.

c) The Facilitator, TCSC, after receiving enquiry for Engineering Consultancy, shall discuss it with the HOD (Civil) for deciding the scope of the work, manpower required to obtain primary/secondary data, whether any outsourcing required etc. and then finalize the probable consultancy charges. The HOD (Civil) shall also discuss with the Facilitator and finalize the rate

For the job, and upon which the Client will be informed about the same and the job will be undertaken accordingly.

The HOD, Civil will then allot the work to concern subject Expert/ Lab In charge for further action. The necessary documentation if required and advance for the work shall also be taken from the Client and then only the work will be undertaken.

4) REVENUE GENERATION:

The revenue from the activity of TCSC will be generated by three ways

a) **From material testing:** The main construction material like Cement, Steel, Bricks, Sand and aggregate required to be tested for possession of certain Engineering properties before using for

the constructions. Since lot of infrastructural construction work is going on in and around of Pune and Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation area, there is a great potential for tapping Contractors executing such work and ask them to bring their material for testing in the laboratories of Civil Engineering Department of the Institute. The rate list for testing of different construction material, Engineering consultancy and Research services mentioned under 'a' & 'b' below will vary according to nature of the work. It will prepared based on present market rates and get approved from the management. The schedule of distribution of income generated from material testing among Management, Principal of the Institute and faculty members involved in the testing activity is given in Schedule.

b) **By offering Engineering consultancy and Civil Engineering Research:** The services offered will include following areas /sectors

- i) Preparation of DPR
- ii) Urban Planning and Management/pre
- iii) Real Estate Planning and Management
- iv) Slum improvement and pro poor housing
- v) Water supply and sewerage



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- vi) Solid waste management
- vii) Environment related issues/Studies like environment monitoring, Environment Impact assessment, Environment Clearance, Hazard and Operability (HAZOP)) Study etc.
- viii) Project management Consultant for Environment issues.
- ix) Bill Checking, its certification and Third Party Audit.
- x) Any other technical Industrial or Academic R&D or assessment services to industries or Social sector organizations
- xi) Support for entrepreneurship development within the student community

The Schedule below is a part of deed. The Facilitator should work as per standard operating Practices (SOPs) which can be prepared for proper delivery of services and such SOP should be revised from time to time. In case of any dispute within the association same shall be arbitrated by arbitrator appointed by trust and the decision shall be final and binding on the associates.

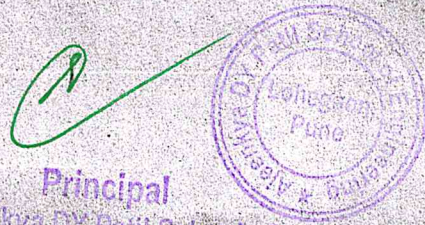

Structure of MoU with S4DS (Society for Data Science)



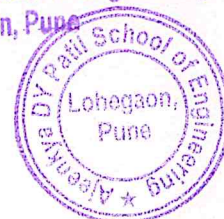

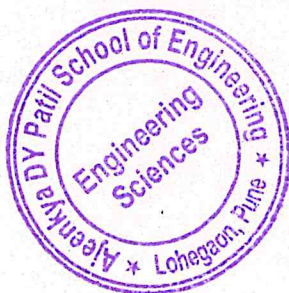
Heronry *birds*, crows also use this *tree* as a nesting site, Fruit and seed of bel trees are a major source of food for birds and certain animals.

This is clear that when these plants will grow it will be of great benefit to our campus.

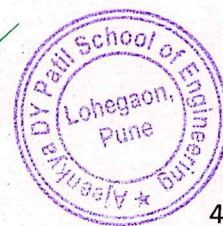
After plantation, watering was done to the plants and it'll be go on as our students promised that they will do watering every day to these plants.

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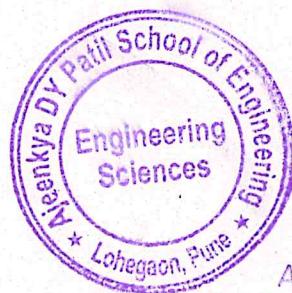
Details of the event:
